HOW TO ACHIEVE THIS LOOK:



1. Use one finger to lift your eyelid gently. Holding your ***Mary Kay*® Waterproof Liquid Eyeliner Pen** at a slight angle to your eyelid, rest the side of your pinky finger against your cheek to steady your hand.



2. Draw a thin line along your top lashline, moving from the inner to the outer corner of your eye.

Pro Tip: Take your time.



3. Then, from the center of your eyelid outward, start building an upward curve one thin stroke at a time, coming to a point at the end of the line. The longer the line, the more dramatic your look.

Pro Tip: Imagine following the curve of your lower lashline as you draw the wing past your upper eyelid.
