How to Use:

- Use wet with liquid or cream or dry with powder.
- Multiple angles allow you to use it with different makeup products and apply with different application techniques for a custom look.
- Works beautifully with:
 - **Liquid makeup** (TimeWise® Luminous or Matte 3D Foundation)
 - **Creamy formulas** (Mary Kay® Multi-Benefit Concealer, Mary Kay® Undereye Corrector or Mary Kay® CC Cream Sunscreen SPF 15)
 - **Powders** (Mary Kay® Silky Setting Powder or Mary Kay® Translucent Loose Powder)
- Customize your look with:
 - **The rounded back** for applying and buffing out foundation.
 - **The pointed corner tip** for getting into tiny, tight areas, such as inner corner of eyes, edges of mouth and sides of nose, and for blending under eyes.
 - **The wide slanted edge** for stippling, or for baking and setting makeup with powder.

Application Tips:

- For liquid or cream, apply the product to the back of your hand, dab the damp sponge into the product and then onto your face. You can also apply the product directly to your face and dab and blend with the damp sponge. Avoid dragging the sponge across your skin.
- For powder, tap the dry sponge into loose powder from the lid or gently dip the sponge into pressed powder and lightly dab onto your face for a baked effect. Avoid dragging the sponge across your skin. You can finish with a powder brush to remove any excess or blend edges.
- Replace sponge every three months.

- You love using different techniques to customize your looks.
- You want the convenience of one applicator that can perform many tasks.
- You need a makeup tool that can apply product even to hard-to-reach places.
- You want a reusable, latex-free makeup applicator option.
